ÿIn terms of Regulations of the Marine Living Resources Act (1998):

\* It is an offence to approach any whale closer than the 300m&rsquo;s without a permit.

\* There is LEGAL boat-based-whale-watching Permit holders in certain areas.

\* No cow-calf whale pairs may be approached by anyone.

\*Clients are advised to ensure that their operator has a permit to approach whales closer than 300m.

\* Clients on board and illegal vessel may be charged with contravening these regulations if the operator approaches a whale closer than 300m&rsquo;s.
